President: Oversees events and organization of the Music Club, provides direction and vision. Needs flexible time commitment. Works closely with Mr. Morton to coordinate various Music Club Activities and with the Treasurer.

Band VP: Oversees and helps band event chairs and band 6 coordinator(s) prepare for parades or music field trips, distribute uniforms, and decorate for concerts. Needs flexible time commitment. It is helpful but not required to be at events.

Orchestra VP: Oversees and helps orchestra event chairs and orchestra 6 coordinator(s) prepare for concerts or music festivals, and distribute uniforms. Needs flexible time commitment. It is helpful but not required to be at events.

Recording Secretary: Takes notes at the music club meetings (once a month), and sends it for meeting minutes' approval at the next meeting. Maintains a record of meeting attendance.

Treasurer: Watches over the budget, prepares checks to various vendors and provides monthly financial statements for each month's music club meetings. Much work can be done at home. Works closely with Mr. Morton and Music Club President.

Band Uniform Coordinator(s): Organizes the distribution of marching band uniforms and shoes to the students. Time commitment is at the beginning of the school year, September and October; and organizes the return of the uniforms at the end of the year (usually in March). This is a great job for you and your friends to do together! Team of 3 Co-Chairs is perfect!

Orchestra Uniform Coordinator(s): Help organize the distribution of the orchestra uniforms to students. Time commitment is at the beginning of the school year, like September and October; and helps organize the return of the uniforms at the end of the year. This is a great job for you and your friends to do together! Team of two Co-Chairs is perfect!

Fundraising Chair: Coordinates the fundraising efforts of Music Club usually a Pie Voucher sale in the Fall/Winter.

Communications Chair: Send informational eblasts that other officers have written to keep all involved. Can be done entirely at home.

Bagpiper Coordinator: Help our bagpipers with their uniforms and during class if needed. Flexible time commitment: Parades & Concerts, Uniform Fitting Day and Return Day.

Band Classroom Aide: Help Mr. Morton in class with clerical tasks. Flexible time commitment during school hours or events.

Orchestra Classroom Aide: Help Mr. Morton in class with clerical tasks. Flexible time commitment during school hours or events.

Music Event Chairs: The following Chairs will help event planning/setting with VP; remind volunteer parents when and where to help during specific events:

Highlander String Orchestra Concert Chair: Coordinates Volunteers for the HSO Concerts and Music Festivals.

Orchestra 6 Coordinator: Coordinates the 6th grade volunteers in conjunction with HSO VP and HSO Concert Chair.

Highlander Band Parade Chair: Coordinate Volunteers for 3 Parades for HB in Fall and Spring

Highlander Band Concert Chair: Coordinates Volunteers for the HB Concerts and works with B6 Coordinator as needed

Band 6 Coordinator: Coordinates the 6th grade volunteers in conjunction with HB VP and HB Concert Chair.

Historian/Videographers: – One Historian for Band and One for Orchestra: Someone to videotape and take pictures of the performances for the different groups. Document the year for the students and Mr. Morton.
